Living the Liturgy

The Second Vatican Council set out its aims in the Constitution on the Liturgy, its first document: "it desires to impart an ever increasing vigour to the Christian life of the faithful; to adapt more suitably to the needs of our own times those institutions which are subject to change; to foster whatever can promote union among all who believe in Christ; to strengthen whatever can help to call the whole of mankind into the household of the Church."

Pope Francis asks us recently, "How do we recover the capacity to live completely the liturgical action?" and sees it as a challenge because modern people have, to varying extents, have lost the capacity to engage with symbolic action, which is an essential part of the liturgical act. We have lost our sense of reference — to value systems, to cultural roots, to community belonging, even to a sense of reality! Think of our constant concern of 'fake' this and that. The use of symbols in our sacramental actions roots us in the concrete world and opens us to encounter the divine. Lent is suffused with such symbolic action.

On Ash Wednesday, we receive the ashes which are an ancient sign of the human condition of the sinner. It expresses our guilt before God in an exterior manner and by doing so, signals our interior commitment to conversion, fired by the confident hope of the Lord's mercy to enkindle the fire of Easter life within us once more. As a day of fasting and abstinence, we physically feel our hunger to what will truly nourish life and holiness within us. As in all sacramental action, the symbols link our outward living with the inner reality of communion with God.
