Born about 454 AD at Faughart, Co Louth, she followed her calling to consecrate her life to God. Tutored by Mel in Ardagh, she fostered that calling in many ways. With Conleth, she founded the double monastery of Kildare. Her spiritual life was given countless expression in welcoming the stranger and showing hospitality to all, in caring for the sick and poor, and in her concern for animals, nature and the Earth. She died on 1st February and was buried in Downpatrick along with Patrick and Columcille.
