Activity - Stay Awake - Friday 20th to Saturday 21st

February - our event aims to create awareness in our young people about the needs of the homeless locally and globally. We will gather at the Chapter rooms at the back of the Cathedral (go in left side of the Cathedral). and grounds round Cathedral, plus the Cathedral indoors for prayer, plus we will walk to the Simion Community to learn about their great work. Early in the morning at 1 am we will walk around Newry asking the young people to identify an outdoor space where they would sleep. SVDP and/or staff from the food bank will also brief us their work. We ask where possible that all young people contribute from their own pocket money £5 or what they can afford up to this amount – funds gathered will be distributed to the charities who have helped us with our event and on a daily basis carry out great work.
