Feasts during the week

Monday is the feast day of St Colman, patron saint of our parish and Diocese. Active in the late fifth and early sixth centuries, he was persuaded by St MacNissi of Bangor to settle at Dromore about 514 AD and he became the first bishop of the diocese.

Wednesday is the feast day of St Columba (or Columcille), one of the patron saints of Ireland. Born at Gartán, Co. Donegal, he founded monasteries at Derry, Durrow and Kells before leaving Ireland as "an exile for Christ" and founding the monastery of Iona from which he evangelised much of western Scotland. He died in 597 AD.

On **Friday** we celebrate the feast of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus, renewing our devotion to the humanity of Jesus through which the Love of God for us made visible.

Saturday is the feast of the Immaculate Heart of Mary.
