Kiltegan Missionary Fathers – 14th August

Fr Patrick McGivern will celebrate masses today to speak about missionary awareness.

St Patrick's Missionary Society, better known as the Kiltegan fathers, was founded on St Patrick's Day 1932, by Fr Patrick Whitney, a priest from the Diocese of Ardagh and Clonmacnois. Since then, Kiltegan priests, together with Volunteer priests and lay people from different Irish Dioceses, including Dromore have worked firstly in Nigeria and later in Kenya, Central and South Africa, Brazil and the West Indies. Today, there are 223 Kiltegan priests of whom 40 are African. We have 58 students in Africa preparing for the priesthood. That seed sown by the Irish church has grown in surprising ways. Through this visit we wish to recall how missionary work is central to our faith and thank you for your generous support in the past.
