Old Bank Notes

The Bank of England will be withdrawing legal tender status of **paper** £20 and £50 banknotes **after 30 September 2022**. The £20 and £50 paper banknotes are now being replaced by the polymer, plastic notes. After this date, paper £20 and £50 banknotes will no longer be legal tender. Anyone who still has these should use them or deposit them at their bank or a Post Office during these last few days.
